

## CONSTITUTION OF THE CALGARY AMATEUR RADIO ASSOCIATION

1. The name of the Society is – The Calgary Amateur Radio Association
2. The objects of the Society are:
  - a) To foster intelligent and serviceable use of Amateur Radio.
  - b) To further international goodwill.
  - c) To cooperate in the observance and enforcement of Amateur Radio laws.
  - d) To present non-partisan information on Amateur Radio activities by operating Official Amateur stations or by such other means as may be deemed expedient.
  - e) To extend assistance towards the clarification of Amateur Radio problems.
  - f) To guard and further the radio interests of the Radio Amateur.
  - g) To promote contests and such other activities as are deemed to give effect to the objects of the Society in the furtherance of the interest of Radio Amateur operators.
  - h) To promote the recreational use, by creating a more comprehensive appreciation of the potential value of Amateur Radio.
  - i) To acquire lands, by purchase or otherwise, erect or otherwise provide a building or buildings for social and community purposes.
  - j) To provide all necessary equipment and furniture for carrying on its various projects.
  - k) To provide a centre and suitable meeting place for the various activities of the community.
  - l) To sell, manage, lease, mortgage, dispose of or otherwise deal with the property of the Society.
3. The operations of the Society are to be chiefly carried on in the City of Calgary in the Province of Alberta.
